He jumped up from the chancel stairs and ran down the center aisle. ...the little boy returned holding the hand of a kind-looking woman in her sixties or seventies, literally pulling her down the aisle. "Here!" He cried, "Here's God! She's here!"

The pastor looked puzzled. "Miss Jean?"

People have asked for a better explanation of RaiseRight and how the program works. **Raiseright** is a program that earns our church some money for every purchase made from its website and contributes to the upkeep of Hope Church.

There are 2 types of fundraising that we participate in.

The first is buying physical gift cards that are offered 3 times during the year. Once in the spring, summer, and late fall right before the Christmas Holidays. The gift cards can be used for yourself or family and friends. There is a wide variety of cards to choose from and each has a percentage of 2.5 to 16% given back. These cards are ordered through our representative and handed out personally, after received. Our next gift card offer will begin on **October 29<sup>th</sup>** and orders taken for the following 2 weeks, ending **November 12th.** The cards will be in by Thanksgiving, so plenty of time to send out as gifts for Christmas.

The other way to participate is through the website directly and purchase Ecards. These are electronic gift cards that are received within minutes of purchase. Go to the **Raiseright** app and download to your phone. Sign up by joining Hope Church using the following enrollment code 5CLADL9436683. Then, while out shopping, purchase **E cards** to use as payment and the church receives a portion of each purchase. There is a .29 charge when purchasing. So while in line, I pull up the app, sign in, and then purchase an e-card close to the anticipated amount or go over and have some funds towards a future purchase available.

#### Book Club October 2023


During October, the Hope Book Club will read and discuss Iuliia Mendel's book, The Fight of Our Lives: My Time With Zelensky, Ukraine's Battle for Democracy, and What It Means for the World.

Inspired by the Ukrainian people: There are already enough stories of heroic resilience to last a lifetime. The Ukrainian novelist Andrey Kurkov even urged his fellow countrymen and women on social media to keep diaries during this challenging time as a future testament to what they lived through. Some of those testimonies are starting to reach a Western audience.

Iuliia Mendel's "The Fight of Our Lives: My Time With Zelensky, Ukraine's Battle for Democracy, and What It Means for the World" is advertised on the back cover as being "written with the sound of Russian bombs and exploding shells in the background." The Ukrainian president's former press secretary recounts how her upbringing in Kherson eventually led her to one of the country's most sought-after positions for journalists, what she witnessed during the beginning of Volodymyr Zelensky's presidency and how Ukraine came together in the face of all-out war. Zelensky was subject to much criticism by the Ukrainian public before the Russian invasion. As Mendel describes, the former comedian and actor was unlike any other president in Ukraine's history. Unsurprisingly, the public was unsure what to make of him once he came to power. The coronavirus pandemic and the Russian invasion forced Zelensky to mature quickly and become a true statesman.

According to *The Washington Post*, Mendel's memoir is best read as a subjective account of the Zelensky administration rather than an authoritative history. Hopefully, the main takeaway for readers is that their interest in Ukraine endures and they will search out the many quality books from Ukraine scheduled to be released in the near future, including from authors currently serving in the Ukrainian military or working tirelessly as volunteers.
